Breuil-Cervinia, (2050 m), a modern tourist resort at the foot of the Matterhorn, hosts an impressive ski area, offering 150 km of runs linking up with the Valtournenche for a total of 24 lifts, plus a cross-border connection with Zermatt, thanks to the Cime Bianche Laghi – Plateau Rosà cableway and the Bontadini chairlift, adding up to a grand total of 360 km of runs. From Plateau Rosà you can either go down towards Zermatt, or take the Ventina run: 11 km downhill from the 3480 m altitude of the beginning of the run to the 2050 m of Cervinia. The Cime Bianche Laghi area (the pick-up point of the cableway for Plateau Rosà) offers a further selection of fantastic downhill runs served by the Goillet chairlift, which provides access to the Valtournenche ski area.

For all multi-days package, we offer a selection of 3* to 5* Hotels; each of them very well located to reach any of the heliski spots. The choice of the hotel is dependent from the season and room availability.

Itinerary:

We meet at ca. 8.30 a.m. in our office in Cervinia. After a hearty welcome, your guide will explain you the daily itinerary and carry out an equipment check. Depending on avalanche, snow and weather conditions the guide will choose the best runs for you. The guide is available to the group for the entire day.

Additional costs:

Ski pass if necessary, rental equipment not included, lunch, drinks, and all other services are not included. Transfer out of the area, if not due to emergency reasons.

Additional flights:

€720.00 per group and per flight.

Refund of helicopter flights:

Multi-days packages incl. vertical meters: There is no refund for down days in general. However, should the flight operation fail due to reasons such as wind, bad weather, avalanche danger or technical problems and the guaranteed vertical meter can't be reached in total, we refund each 250 vertical meters below the refund threshold at a rate of 180.00 Euro per group. There is no refund due to illness, accident, lack of fitness, insufficient skiing skills, late arrival and breaks during the ski day.

Heliski day incl. flights: Should the flight operation fail completely due to reasons such as wind, bad weather, avalanche danger or technical problems, we refund the full amount to the customer. If the group is not able to do all the flights included in the package due to reasons such as wind, bad weather, avalanche danger or technical problems, we refund each unflown flight with 460,- € per group. There is no refund due to illness, accident, lack of fitness, insufficient skiing skills, late arrival and breaks during the ski day.
