#### **UNDERTAKES**

9. to comply with all the indications provided by the Mountain Guide during the activity, including those concerning equipment, clothing, and safety.
10. to participate to the daily Briefing, held by the mountain guide, to be informed in particular of the avalanche risk of the day of the activity and of the risk of falling into crevasses, in the event that the activity takes place in part or entirely on a glacier:

11. to have been informed in detail of the activity in which he/she intends to participate, the characteristics and schedule of the relevant program, as well as the equipment, clothing and specific technical skills necessary for this purpose
12. to have read and to accept the conditions and rates applied by Heli Guides S.r.l., in relation to the chosen activity;
13. to free Heli Guides S.r.l. (including directors, managers, employees, collaborators, consultants, etc.) and mountain guides that lent their professional work to the chosen activity, from each and any liability for any damage, to the person and/or to things that may occur during the participation in the activities, except those covered by legal terms.
14. to undertake to indemnify and hold Heli Guides S.r.l. (including directors, collaborators, consultants, etc.) and individual Mountain Guides harmless of any and every liability, including any legal fees, for alleged damages, losses or injuries caused to third parties and/or their property due to his/her conduct.
15. that images and sounds related to the participation of the activities of Heli Guides S.r.l. recorded by his/her own with any audio or video equipment will not be used for any purpose other than private and domestic.
16. not to sell, transmit, publish or make, in general, commercial use of the aforementioned recordings and/or images and not to commercially exploit his/her participation in the activities of Heli Guides S.r.l. in any way and by any means.
